





Voices from the Tonga National Data System



Tonga Statistics Dept – 96% of the Tongan population are Tongans therefore, breakdown by ethnicity is not a priority

Tonga Statistics Dept – even though we are in the coordination team its important we have some subject matter knowledge as it helps when we get asked statistical questions while out and about

Ministry of Justice – and what ethnicity do you give to a child with a Tongan mother but Chinese father?

Voices from the Tonga National Data System



Education – we need the population estimates before the year starts to help determine the expected enrolment no. for primary schools for all island groups

Education – We only need one population estimates for Tonga, WB, SPC, and other agencies have different methods and provided different result – not sure which one to believe

Tonga Provident Fund – we need the population estimates by age group to plan ahead for the retirement fund payout

All participants – data collection, system, legal framework, timeliness, accuracy, completeness are a huge challenge



DEFINITION OF POPULATION ESTIMATES VS POPULATION PROJECTION

An **estimate** is a calculation of the size or distribution of a population or another characteristic of the population for the **present or past**, while a **projection** describes these characteristics in the **future**.
